RESOURCES

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES (species, escapement, timing, spawning area):
pinks and chum, no coho fry observed, however, there is rearing area available for a
small number; no escapement data known, but similar size streams in the area do have
spawning populations of pinks and chums.

Spawning Area: 375 meters² (see map).

Schooling Areas: at the mouth.

Spawning Areas: good areas near the mouth; scattered areas upstream.

SHELLFISH POTENTIAL: there is a popular sport dungeness crab fishery in Port Real
Marina.

SPORT FISHERIES: none.

LAND USE (history, present, proposed): unknown; presently in a natural state.

REHABILITATION POTENTIAL: none needed.

SOILS: generally stable.

GAME RESOURCES (species, use, habitat): reportedly good fur bearer habitat in
this area.
