RESOURCES

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES (species, escapement, timing, spawning area):  
pink, chum and coho; fair rearing for coho  
timing - late (September)

Spawning area: 206m<sup>2</sup> total; upper section (763'x6'x20%ASA)=85m<sup>2</sup>; lower section  
Schooling Areas: at the stream mouth (339'x7'x55%ASA)=121m<sup>2</sup>

Spawning Areas: in a short intertidal section and scattered throughout the remainder  
of the surveyed section of the stream

SHELLFISH POTENTIAL: good populations of abalone on nearby exposed rocks

SPORT FISHERIES: one 7" Dolly Varden was observed during the survey, but the  
stream generally has a low potential for sport fishing

LAND USE (history, present, proposed): there is a logged area to the south  
of the stream mouth, age unknown

REHABILITATION POTENTIAL: none needed

SOILS: generally stable (see map)

GAME RESOURCES (species, use, habitat): deer and bear tracks noted at the  
stream mouth
