RESOURCES

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES (species, escapement, timing, spawning area):
Numerous coho fry. Pink and chum salmon.

Spawning area estimate: 1840 m²
 Schooling Areas: In intertidal zone.

Spawning Areas: Along entire length of survey.

SHELLFISH POTENTIAL: Clam, mussels.

SPORT FISHERIES: None noted.

LAND USE (history, present, proposed): Presently consists of second growth trees, as the areas was previously clearcut.

REHABILITATION POTENTIAL: None recommended, windfalls along east edge of clear-cut may reflect instability as a result of logging the area.

SOILS: Banks falls into stream around 1300' mark.

GAME RESOURCES (species, use, habitat): Sandhill cranes, waterfowl area, probably deer and bear in the area.
