SUBJECT: Klawok Creek Dolly Varden fishery

Since Roger is not in town, I will answer your April 24 inquiry about a Department inspector on the Klawok Creek Dolly Varden fishery.

The place to start in is asking Carl to stipulate the species to be taken (Dolly Varden) along with the usual specs on net size, mesh, dates, etc. I don't believe a stipulation for Department inspector would be needed. If an excess of other species were taken or damaged, the operational methods could be changed or the permit terminated. Certainly an inspector can be on the operation, and if a possible problem is in the offing, should be. I assume we can provide the man power.
