





Anchorage: Various anchorages available in Trocadero Bay including "Big Bay" at
the head of which lies this stream.
Tide Stage when Surveyed: Low.

RESOURCES

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES (species, escapement, timing, spawning area):

Pink, chum, coho

Timing - September, October.

SPAWNING AREA; 5310 m² (2000'x30'x75% ASA) + (3000'x20'x20% ASA) + (250'x40'x80% ASA)

Schooling Areas: At drop off of flats near mouth, small pools throughout accessible
portion.

Spawning Areas: Good gravel riffles in intertidal portion and upstream to velocity
gradient barriers.

SHELLFISH POTENTIAL: Flats are large enough to support a small crab population
although none observed.

SPORT FISHERIES: None near stream. Possibly some small cutthroat in beaver ponds.

LAND USE (history, present, proposed): Stream valley has been extensively
logged.

REHABILITATION POTENTIAL: Stream clearance and beaver dam removal at some
future time when stream becomes more stabilized.

SOILS: Stream is very braided but little active slumpage observed. Channels may
consolidate in future years.

GAME RESOURCES (species, use, habitat): Bear and wolf sign along creek
where they are feeding on salmon. Much beaver sign and large areas of good habitat.
Approx. 100 seagulls on flat and 75 scooters in bay.
