RESOURCES

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES (species, escapement, timing, spawning area):
coho and pinks; good rearing in pools foair rearing overall for coho.

SPAWNING AREA: estimated 150 meters².
Schooling Areas: at the mouth.

Spawning Areas: little spawning area intertidally, scattered areas upstream.

SHELLFISH POTENTIAL: unknown, only one small intertidal gravel flat near the mouth.

SPORT FISHERIES: limited, due to the small size of stream.

LAND USE (history, present, proposed): unknown; presently in a natural state.

REHABILITATION POTENTIAL: none needed.

SOILS: generally stable; a steep bank area 300' upstream and a braided area 1200'
upstream.

GAME RESOURCES (species, use, habitat): deer and bear in the area.
