### RESOURCES

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES (species, escapement, timing, spawning area):  
Primarily a pink salmon system with several excellent spawning areas. Rearing coho present. Fair rearing areas. Peak escapements: 20,000 pinks, 8/14/75; 3,000 chum, 9/5/57.

SPAWNING AREA: 1900 M<sup>2</sup> (from map).

Salmon bones noted.

Schooling Areas: At the mouth.

Spawning Areas: Throughout the lower 1/2 mile of the stream.

SHELLFISH POTENTIAL: Low.

SPORT FISHERIES: Little potential due to small size of stream and limited rearing areas.

LAND USE (history, present, proposed): Unknown, presently in a natural state.

REHABILITATION POTENTIAL: None needed.

SOILS: Generally stable.

GAME RESOURCES (species, use, habitat): Abundant game trails near the stream; well used by bear, deer and wolves.
