



COMMERCIAL FISHERIES (species, escapement, timing, spawning area):  
Coho present. No escapement data. Good rearing for coho.

SPAWNING AREA: 855 M<sup>2</sup> (see map)

Schooling Areas: At mouth.

Spawning Areas: Distributed throughout the stream length.

SHELLFISH POTENTIAL: Unknown.

SPORT FISHERIES: Unknown. The lake at the headwaters may have a small cutthroat  
population.

LAND USE (history, present, proposed): Much of the eastern side of the stream  
has been clearcut.

REHABILITATION POTENTIAL: A large amount of debris in the stream may cause a  
blockage in the future.

SOILS: Generally stable.

GAME RESOURCES (species, use, habitat): Unknown.
