Dear Sir:

In response to your recent request you are hereby advised that this letter constitutes a formal amendment to the above-captioned right-of-way permit.

The effect is to allow the construction and maintenance of an access road fifteen feet (15') in width and approximately five hundred and twenty-five feet (525') in length, located in Lot Four (4) of U.S. Survey No. 3832. It is our understanding that the road is to be utilized in conjunction with the pipeline construction and planned fish hatchery site.

We assume that the plat submitted to us reflects the correct road location; should any change occur during construction, we would appreciate being advised so that our records may be noted accordingly. This amendment is for the purpose of allowing an additional use under this conveyance, therefore, the terms and conditions of the original permit remain in full force and effect and apply to both tracts.
