
Dear Jim:

On May 16, 1977, I had one of my crews go up Sawmill Creek and measure the streamflow.

Streamflow determinations were taken at both of the stations we had measured earlier. The upper station showed a flow rate of 50 cfs while the lower showed 60 cfs (see attached data sheet). These flows were taken after a period of sunshine and no rain.

Since we are continuing with dry conditions and further reduced streamflows, I suggest we open the fish valve to the established 50 cfs flow as soon as practicable.
