

REPORT FOR GAME FISH STOCKING PROGRAM

Alaska Game Commission

Boulder LAKE

LOCATION: Above Anan Lake head Ernest Sound

LATITUDE: 56°15' LONGITUDE: 131°45' DRAINS INTO: Anan Lake Ernest Sound

ELEVATION: Approx 250 feet. AREA OF LAKE: Approx 500 acres

LENGTH OF OUTLET STREAM: 500 yards EMPTIES INTO: Anan Lake

WATER: Quite brown with muskeg DEPTH: Unknown (Seems quite deep)

TEMPERATURE: SURFACE: 57° F at 1300

SHORE LINE: GRAVELLY: 10% BANKS: SLOPE: Abrupt 95% GENTLE: 5%

FOOD SUPPLY: Cottoids, insect larvae and insects.

PRESENT FISH FOUND IN LAKE OR STREAM: Cutthroat, cottoids.

SPAWNING GROUNDS: Head of the lake was not reached. Outlet very poor.

RECOMMENDED STOCKING WITH: Nothing

IS WATER USED BY SPAWNING SALMON? I don't think salmon can ascend the outlet creek.

DISCUSS STREAM, FALLS, RAPIDS, ETC., IN RELATION TO FISH MOVEMENT AND SPAWNING

GROUNDS: Outlet very steep with many divisions in the stream and much white water.

Appears that a large slide dammed the canyon. Many large granite boulders and under channels.

IS THERE A TRAIL TO LAKE? No. ALONG STREAM? No. COULD PLANTING OF GAME FISH

BE DONE BEST BY TRAIL OR PLANE? Plane if necessary.

REMARKS: Lake only touched at the outlet and information above gathered from that and topographical maps.
