

CLOVER LAKE

Elevation	1,354 feet
Area	250 acres (estimated)
Depth	Not sounded
Water	Light brown
Bottom	Slide rock, muck
Watershed	Alpine type; many rock outcrops, some hemlock-cedar ground cover.
Aquatic Vegetation	Very little; some yellow pond lilies, potamogeton, valisneria.
Inlets	One main, one unsuitable for spawning and several intermittent tributaries.
Outlet	Good spawning area, flow approximately 10 C.F.S. at normal flows, drops precipitiously to a small lake below.
Chem.	Very little dissolved material, pH approximately 6.6.
Temp.	Will reach 68° F.
Fish	No fish known to be in the lake.
Critique	The location of this lake on Prince of Wales Island and being accessible only by plane has prevented an extensive survey of it. Was planted with 20,000 eyed rainbow eggs in July which were put in the gravel of the outlet stream.
