

January Lake of 186 acres lies on Revillagigedo Island between Grace and Manzanita Lakes. Its elevation is 640 ft. and there are barrier falls in the outlet stream. The lake lies in timbered and muskeg country and has a drainage area of 1344 acres. The water is brown with organic stain, less than 15 ppm of calcium hardness and a pH of near 6. The lake was planted with steelhead fry in 1961 and an excellent rainbow population has resulted.

Net

An experimental gill net was set and retrieved after three days on August 25. The catch was 8 rainbow trout ranging 8.75 to 15.25 inches. These fish showed 2 annuli on the scales of the smallest ones to 5 on the largest. As many as 3 spawn checks were noted. Two of the catch were fish of the original plant. Angler use of the lake has not been heavy due to no facilities on the lake and access by float-plane only.
