

67. Heckman Lake *101-90 - 10500*

Part of the Naha River drainage (see #33). Proposed with High Priority in the Phase II document, removed from high priority in 1984, pending results of the McDonald and Hugh Smith Lake fertilization programs. Limnological studies were conducted in the late 1980s.

68. Klawock Lake *103-60 - 10470*

Limnological studies were done from 1986 – 1989 to evaluate lake productivity in conjunction with fry releases from Klawock Hatchery. The lake is not considered a good candidate for fertilization because of the high flushing rate.
