Once again we missed you while making a very brief survey of Lower Dewey Lake. Did attempt to reach you but found no one home.


We set sample nets in Lower Dewey Lake to obtain a fish sample for growth analysis and to guide us in our future stockings.

I'm certainly pleased with the fish in Dewey Lake and their general condition. These are some of the finest rainbow I've seen in quite some time. It was also encouraging to encounter a number of anglers on the lake.

I intend to plant the lake again in late July or August with approximately 10,000 rainbow fingerling. This should complete our stocking program as the first year stocking can be expected to spawn this next spring.

Just thought I'd keep you posted on our activities up your way and hope Skagway fishermen continue to enjoy those rainbow.
