Clerk-Typist Class Opens

Persons interested in enrolling in a clerk-typist course scheduled for eighteen weeks starting June 24 should contact the State Employment Service Office, 123 Seward Street, between 9 a.m. and noon or between 1 and 4 p.m., Monday thru Friday.

The course will be taught at the Community College, Fifth and Seward, and will include subjects in typewriting, filing, office machines, business arithmetic, business English, introduction to card punch operation and office etiquette.

Instructors for the course will be Mrs. Phyllis Beima, Miss Elma Olson, and Larry Saunders.

Preference is given to persons with high school education, General Education Developments (GED) or previous work experience equal to the number of years not completed in high school. The student will attend school seven or eight hours per day between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

There is no charge for tuition or books to the students accepted into the course, and some students may be eligible for training allowances.

Q. What's the name of this meat cooking method?

A. Panfrying.

Q. How is panfrying done?

A. Melt two or more tablespoons of lard or drippings in a frying-pan. To this, add meat, dredged in seasoned flour or not as desired. Brown at moderate temperature turning occasionally to assure even cooking. Meat must not be covered during frying because when covered it is braised. In frying, meat should be cooked when both sides are browned.
