Dear Senator Stevens:

Reference is made to Commissioner Reetz' letter of June 13 to you concerning improvement work on Swan Lake at Sitka. It appears that this project might well be assisted by federal Land and Water Conservation Fund monies.

We would be happy to accept for review an application from the City of Sitka or other competent local government agency. As you probably know, the decision on funding the projects in the state is made by a committee composed of Secretary of State Robert Ward, Commissioner of Administration Thomas Downes and myself.

For your further information, the City of Sitka has recently submitted a proposal for development of Crescent Park surrounding the Crescent Boat Harbor. Thus, they are aware of our procedures and requirements and should find no difficulty in submitting the project proposal.
