

# Kodiak Island ~~~ Fresh Waters

## SEASONS, BAG AND POSSESSION LIMITS:

### KING SALMON:

Season: Open all year  
 Daily limits: less than 20"—10 daily, 10 in possession.  
 20" or longer—2 daily, 2 in possession.  
 Annual limit: No more than 5 per year, 20" or longer.  
 Harvest record required.

### OTHER SALMON (SOCKEYE, COHO, PINK, CHUM):

Season: Open all year  
 Limits: (in the Kodiak Remote Zone—see map)  
 20" or longer (total combination of all species)—5 daily, 10 in possession.  
 less than 20"—10 daily, 10 in possession.  
 Limits: (in the Kodiak Road Zone—see map)  
 20" or longer (total combination of all species)—5 daily, 5 in possession (only 2 may be coho, and only 2 may be sockeye salmon).  
 less than 20"—10 daily, 10 in possession.

### RAINBOW/STEELHEAD TROUT:

Daily limits: (in the Kodiak Remote Zone—see map)  
 2 daily, 2 in possession (only one 20" or longer).  
 Annual limit: No more than 2 per year, 20 inches or longer.  
 Harvest record required.  
 Daily limits: (in the Kodiak Road Zone—see map)  
 Catch-and-release only; bait restrictions apply. (See exceptions for stocked lakes.)

### DOLLY VARDEN AND GRAYLING:

Season: Open all year  
 Limits: 10 daily, 10 in possession, no size limits.

### OTHER:

Open all year; no daily bag, possession or size limits. □

## AREA BAIT RESTRICTIONS:

In the fresh water of the road zone, from November 1–April 30, **only unbaited, artificial lures** may be used (road zone stocked lakes, Chiniak and Barry lagoons, and Southern Lake are exempted). □

## WATERS CLOSED TO ALL SPORT FISHING:

**Dog Salmon River**, from the Frazer fish pass to 200 yd downstream, is closed to sport fishing June 1–Aug. 31.

**Pillar and Monashka Creek drainages** above the highway are closed to sport fishing year-round, and the east bank of Monashka Creek, from the highway bridge to a sign about 50 yd downstream, is closed year-round to sport fishing. □

## EXCEPTIONS AND CLOSED WATERS—SALMON:


- In Saltery Cove streams, only 2 fish of the 5 salmon bag limit (for salmon other than king salmon) may be coho salmon; all 5 may be sockeye salmon.
- The Karluk and Ayakulik rivers are closed to king salmon fishing July 26–Dec. 31.
- Island Lake Creek is **closed year-round to salmon fishing**.
- Streams flowing into Chiniak Bay, upstream from the highway are **closed to salmon fishing Aug. 1–Sept. 15** (except Buskin River drainage, which is open year-round).
- Little Kitoi Lake and Creek are **closed to salmon fishing Aug. 15–Sept. 30**.
- Dog Salmon drainage is **closed to king salmon fishing**. □

## EXCEPTIONS—RAINBOW/STEELHEAD TROUT:

- **Stocked lakes on the Kodiak road zone:** In Abercrombie (Gertrude), Aurel, Big, Bull, Caroline, Cicely, Dolgoi, Dragonfly, Heitman, Horseshoe, Jack, Jupiter, Lee, Lily Pond (Peninsula) Lake, Long, Saturn, Tanignak, and East Twin lakes, the daily bag and possession limit is 10 rainbow trout (only 1 may be 20" or longer). No annual limit. □

### REMOTE ZONE:

All of the Kodiak Island area **outside of the ROAD ZONE**.



**KODIAK ISLAND ROAD ZONE:** All fresh waters of Kodiak Island east of a line from Crag Pt. south to the westernmost point of Saltery Cove, including waters of Woody, Long, and Spruce islands, and all salt waters bordering the Road Zone within 1 mile of Spruce Island and Kodiak Island.
