**Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement # 13
EO 19**

This is the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in King Salmon with an announcement for Naknek-Kvichak District fishermen. The time is 9:00 a.m. and the date is Tuesday, June 25.

The Naknek River escapement on June 24 was 36,500 for a cumulative of 92,000. The Kvichak in-river estimate is 40,000. There are 169 vessels registered to fish in the district and there will be an increase to 243 vessels in 48 hours.

The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to drift gillnet gear for a 7.5-hour period from 7:30 p.m. Tuesday, June 25 until 3:00 a.m. Wednesday, June 26 and again for a 9-hour period from 6:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 26. The current set gillnet period in the Naknek-Kvichak District will be extended for 24.5 hours from 3:00 p.m. Tuesday, June 25 until 3:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 26.

Fishermen in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand-by at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday, June 26 for the next possible announcement.
