**Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement # 27
EO 37**

This is the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in King Salmon with an announcement for Naknek-Kvichak District fishermen. The time is 9:00 a.m. and the date is Tuesday, July 2, 2019.

On July 1, the Naknek River escapement was 84,000 for a cumulative of 498,000. The Kvichak River escapement was 7,000 for a cumulative of 19,000. The Kvichak in-river estimate is 15,000. Harvest on July 1 was an estimated 350,000 for a cumulative of 1.3 million. The allocation is 76% drift, 16% Naknek set net, and 8% Kvichak set net. There are 290 vessels registered to fish in the district.

The Naknek Section will open to drift gillnet gear for an 18-hour period from 1:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 3. The current set gillnet period in the Naknek-Kvichak District will be extended for 25 hours from 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 2 until 7:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 3.

Fishermen in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand-by at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 3 for the next possible announcement.
