**Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement # 45
EO 56**

This is the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in King Salmon with an announcement for Naknek-Kvichak District fishermen. The time is 9:00 a.m. and the date is Wednesday, July 10, 2019.

On July 9, the Naknek River escapement was 118,000 for a cumulative of 1.3 million; the Kvichak River escapement was 125,000 for a cumulative of 231,000; and the Alagnak River escapement was 31,000 for a cumulative of 82,000. The Kvichak in-river estimate is 250,000. Harvest on July 9 was an estimated 980,000 for a cumulative of 6.2 million. There are 383 vessels registered to fish in the district and there will be 482 vessels in 48 hours.

The Naknek Section will open to drift gillnet gear for an 8-hour period from 8:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 10 until 4:00 a.m. Thursday, July 11 and again for a 7.5-hour period from 8:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. Thursday, July 11. The current set gillnet period in the Naknek-Kvichak District will be extended for 25 hours from 2:30 p.m. Wednesday, July 10 until 3:30 p.m. Thursday, July 11.

Fishermen in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand-by at 9:00 a.m. Thursday, July 11 for the next possible announcement.
