**Kuskokwim River Salmon Fishery Announcement #10  
Emergency Order #3-S-WR-9-19**

This is an announcement from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in Bethel for fishermen in the Kuskokwim Area. The Kuskokwim River Salmon Management Working Group unanimously supported these management actions at the most recent meeting held in Bethel.

**Commercial fishing will open in Subdistrict 1-A for five 8-hour periods with 6-inch or less mesh gillnets that may not exceed 50 fathoms in length and not more than 45 meshes deep:**

- 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Friday, August 16
- 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Saturday, August 17
- 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 21
- 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Friday, August 23
- 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Saturday, August 24

**Subdistrict 1-A:** This area is defined as that portion of District 1 upstream of regulatory markers located at Bethel to ADF&G regulatory markers at the mouth of Bogus Creek.

**There are no commercial salmon processors in the Kuskokwim Management Area at this time. This opportunity is being provided for those individuals registered with the department as catcher/sellers.**
