SITKA SOUND HERRING FISHERY UPDATE # 13

Sitka...Today's aerial survey covered the Sitka Sound area from Cape Burunof to Salisbury Sound. Weather during the flight was good with light winds and clear skies. A total of 7.7 nautical miles of active herring spawn was observed on Kruzof Island south of Shelikof Bay, Fred's Creek, from Inner Point to Point Brown, and on Krestof Island from Rob Point to Eastern Bay, and in the Magoun Islands. Smaller areas of spawn were observed closer to Sitka north of Watson Point and near Crescent Harbor (Figure 1). The cumulative miles of herring spawn to date is approximately 25.3 nautical miles.

The next aerial survey will be Sunday, April 5 and the next fishery update will be issued by Monday, April 6.

The department is experimenting with a mobile data collection app used during herring surveys to provide interactive maps for displaying survey spawning information. The "Sitka Sound daily herring spawn" map displays spawn location data for the current day and the "Sitka Sound herring surveys" map allows users to view all of the data collected for each survey throughout the 2020 season. Survey data have not been edited and are for reference purposes only. Because these maps are still under development, feedback is appreciated.
