This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak District. The time is 9:00 a.m. and the date is Thursday, July 9, 2020.

Naknek-Kvichak District

Time: 9:00 a.m.

On July 8, Naknek River escapement was 584,000 for a cumulative of 2 million; Alagnak River escapement was 119,000 for a cumulative of 365,000; and Kvichak River escapement was 200,000 for a cumulative of 585,000. The Kvichak inriver estimate is 500,000. Harvest in the Naknek-Kvichak District on July 8 was an estimated 1 million for a cumulative of 5.8 million.

The Naknek Section will open to drift gillnet gear for a 6.5-hour period from 4:30 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. Thursday, July 9 and again for an 8.5-hour period from 4:30 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. Friday, July 10. The current set gillnet period in the Naknek-Kvichak District will be extended for 24.5-hours from 12:30 p.m. Thursday, July 9 until 1:00 p.m. Friday, July 10.
