Alsek River: will be open from 12:01 p.m., Sunday, August 16, through 12:00 noon, Wednesday, August 19, 2020.

East Alsek River: will be open from 12:01 p.m., Sunday, August 16, through 12:00 noon, Wednesday, August 19, 2020.

Yakutat Bay: will be open from 12:01 p.m., Sunday August 16, through 12:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 19, 2020.

Dangerous River: will be open from 12:01 p.m., Sunday August 16, through 12:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 19, 2020.

Akwe River: will be open from 12:01 p.m., Sunday August 16, through 12:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 19, 2020.
