SOUTHEAST ALASKA GOLDEN KING CRAB PERSONAL USE FISHERY

The personal use golden king crab fishery in the Northern, East Central, Mid-Chatham Strait, and Lower Chatham Strait management areas will open at 12:00 noon, Wednesday, February 17, 2021.




Figure 1. Effective at 12:00 noon, February 17, 2021, waters of Southeast Alaska open to the retention of personal use golden king crab. This map is for reference purposes only.
