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**2020/21 SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL SEA CUCUMBER FISHERY  
ANNOUNCEMENT**

The following area will be closed for the remainder of the 2020/21 sea cucumber season:

**District 9:**

Southeast Baranof (Subdistrict 109-10).

The following area will be open from **8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., Monday, February 15, and Tuesday, February 16, 2021:**

**District 8:**

South Mitkof and North Zarembo Islands (Subdistrict 108-30).

The following areas will be open from **8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. on Monday, February 15, Tuesday, February 16, and Wednesday, February 17, 2021:**

**District 13:**

Baranof Island Shoreline, Necker, and Rakof Islands, West Crawfish Inlet, and Crawfish Inlet (Subdistricts 113-31, 32, and 33);

Sitka Sound (Subdistricts 113-38 and 41).

For a description of the above areas, please refer to the Southeast Alaska commercial sea cucumber fishery announcement dated August 31, 2020, announcing the open areas and their guideline harvest levels (GHL). The next advisory announcement following this opening will be available on **Thursday, February 18, 2021.**

**ADF&G offices will be closed, Monday, February 15, 2021, for Presidents' Day.**

The Emergency Order corresponding with this announcement is EO 1M1221.
