Westside Salmon Announcement 3 Emergency Order 4

Under Alaska's Health Advisories 1, 2, 3, and 4, commercial fishing is an Essential Business and is part of Alaska's Essential Services and Critical Infrastructure. Commercial fishermen should ensure that all travel and other activities in support of commercial fishing operations follow protocols in Alaska COVID-19 Health Advisories. This is the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in Dillingham with an announcement regarding commercial fishing in the Nushagak District. This is Westside Salmon Announcement number 3 issued Wednesday, June 16 at 12:00 noon.

As previously announced, commercial fishing with set gillnets will close at 1:00 p.m. June 16. Commercial fishing will open with set gillnets only, in the Igushik Section only, for three eight-hour periods, from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Thursday, June 17, from 6:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. Friday, June 18, and 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Saturday, June 19. Additionally, mesh size for all commercial fishing in the Nushagak District is restricted to 5.5 inch mesh or smaller for the conservation of king salmon until further notice.

Permit holders are reminded that District Registration Cards must be filled out and filed with the department before they begin commercial fishing.
