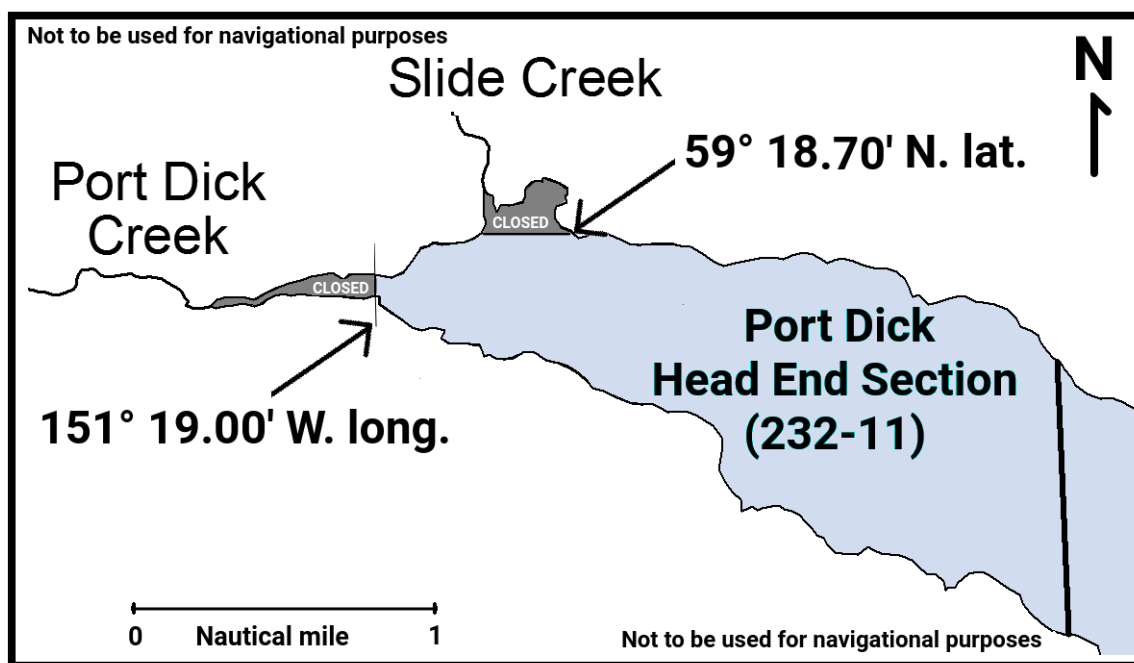

Lower Cook Inlet Salmon Fishery Announcement #14

OUTER DISTRICT: Effective at 6:00 AM on Friday, August 6, the closed waters area for the head end section of the west arm of Port Dick, (5AAC 21.350(f)(8)) is modified. Commercial salmon fishing is permitted in those waters of that section that are both south of 59° 18.70' N. lat. and east of 151° 19.00' W. long. See Figure 1 below,
