KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #34 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-34-21

The following areas will <u>close</u> to commercial salmon fishing at 9:00 p.m. Saturday, August 14: - The Izhut Bay and Outer Kitoi Bay Sections of the Afognak District.

There will be a <u>24-hour extension</u> to the current commercial salmon fishing period in the **Duck Bay Section** of the **Afognak District** from **9:00 p.m. Saturday, August 14** to **9:00 p.m. Sunday, August 15**.

There will be a <u>48-hour extension</u> to the current commercial salmon fishing period from 9:00 p.m. Sunday, August 15 until 9:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 17 in the following areas:

- The Northwest Kodiak District;
- The Southwest Afognak Section of the Afognak District;
- The Outer Ayakulik Section of the Southwest Kodiak District;
- The Cape Alitak, Humpy Deadman, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay Sections of the Alitak District; and
- The Sitkalidak, Two-Headed, and Seven Rivers Sections of the Eastside Kodiak District.

As previously Announced:

The following areas will <u>close</u> to commercial salmon fishing at 9:00 p.m. Saturday, August 14:

- The Raspberry Strait, Northwest Afognak, Perenosa Bay, Northeast Afognak, and Southeast Afognak Sections of the Afognak District;
- The Northeast Kodiak District (except the Buskin River Section will remain closed);
- The Inner and Outer Ugak Bay Sections of the Eastside Kodiak District; and
- The **Mainland District** (except the Inner Kukak Bay Section remains closed).

Closed Water Adjustment:

Closed waters are **reduced** from **noon Saturday**, August 14 <u>until further notice</u> at Humpy Cove, to the stream terminus of Humpy Creek (stream #257-701), and stream #257-703.

The Spiridon Bay Special Harvest Area (Telrod Cove) remains <u>open</u> to commercial salmon fishing <u>until</u> <u>further notice:</u>

Cost recovery fisheries began in the Kitoi Bay Special Harvest Area (SHA) on August 8. Fishing opportunities in the Duck Bay, Izhut Bay, Inner Kitoi Bay, and Outer Kitoi Bay sections will be dependent on the ability to meet KRAA cost recovery needs, and all cost recovery information can be obtained by calling 486-6559.

<u>Until further notice</u>, in that portion of the Northwest Kodiak and Southwest Kodiak districts south of the latitude of Cape Kuliuk, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350). Statistical Charts, Harvest Strategies, and Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations are available at the Kodiak Fish and Game office. Recent salmon fishery information may be obtained by calling the Department's 24-hour record-a-phone at 486-4559.
