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**2021/22 SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL SEA CUCUMBER FISHERY
ANNOUNCEMENT**

The following area will be closed the remainder of the 2021/22 sea cucumber fishery season:

District 2

Kasaan Bay and Skowl Arm (Subdistrict 102-60).

The following area will be open from **8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday, December 13, 2021, and from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, Tuesday, December 14, 2021:**

District 3

Trocadero Bay (Subdistrict 103-60).

The following areas will be open from **8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, December 12, Monday, December 13, and Tuesday, December 14, 2021:**

District 2

Lower Clarence Strait (Subdistrict 102-20);

District 3

Hetta Inlet, Nutkwa Inlet, and Keete Inlet (Subdistricts 103-23 and 25).

For a description of the above areas, please refer to the Southeast Alaska commercial sea cucumber fishery announcement dated August 19, 2021, announcing the open areas and their guideline harvest levels (GHL). The next advisory announcement following this opening will be available on **Thursday, December 16, 2021.**

The Emergency Order corresponding with this announcement is EO 1M5621.
