SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL GEODUCK FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

The following area will be open for the commercial harvest of geoduck for live sale **with a 400-pound harvest limit from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 26, and from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Thursday, January 27, 2022:**

Kelp Island (Subdistrict 101-21-001): will be open for a remaining harvest of 6,500 pounds of geoduck.

Fishermen are reminded that unless otherwise specified, regulations regarding the geoduck fishery are stated in 5 AAC 38.142: Southeastern Alaska Geoduck Fishery Management Plan.

For a description of the above area, please refer to the Southeast Alaska commercial geoduck fishery announcement dated September 17, 2021, announcing the open areas and their guideline harvest levels. All companies buying geoduck clams must contact the Fish and Game, Ketchikan office with a harvest report before **12:00 noon on Friday, January 28, 2022.**

The Emergency Order corresponding with this announcement is EO 1M0722.
