DISTRICT 11 DRIFT GILLNET FISHERY EXTENSION CORRECTION

The District 11 Drift Gillnet Fishery Extension announcement issued at approximately 10:01 a.m. on June 28, 2022, contained an incorrect date. The information below has been reflected to show the corrected date of the fishery extension.

Section 11-B: will be **extended for 10 hours and will close at 10:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 28, 2022**, with the following restrictions:

Taku Inlet/Stephens Passage: will be closed north of 58°14.70' N lat (approximately 0.5 nautical miles (nmi) north of Cooper Point);

Limestone Inlet: will be closed east of a line from a point on the north shore at 58°02.04' N lat, 133°59.60' W long to a point on the south shore at 58°01.75' N lat, 133°59.40' W long (outside markers);

Port Snettisham: will be closed east of a line from Point Styleman at 57°58.42' N lat, 133°53.93' W long to Point Anmer at 57°56.09' N lat, 133°51.01' W long;

Gillnet mesh restriction: maximum allowed mesh size is 6 inches.

This announcement was made on the fishing grounds via VHF radio on channel 10 at approximately 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, June 28, 2022.
