PORT MOLLER COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #7 **For Emergency Orders #4-FS-M-PM-7-22**

The Bear River and Three Hills Sections will remain closed to commercial salmon fishing. That portion of the Ilnik Section located southwest of a 300 degree bearing perpendicular to the beach at 159° 42.04' W. long. will remain closed to commercial salmon fishing until further notice. The remaining portion of the Ilnik Section will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Thursday, June 30 until 6:00 p.m. Friday, July 1. The Port Moller Bight Section will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Thursday, June 30 until 6:00 p.m. Friday, July 1.
