KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #20 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-20-22

There will be an <u>81-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Tuesday**, **August 2** to **9:00 p.m. Friday**, **August 5** in the following areas:

- The Cape Alitak, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay Sections of the Alitak District;
- The **Northwest Kodiak District** (except the Anton Larsen Bay, Sharatin Bay, Kizhuyak Bay, and Spiridon Bay Sections will remain closed); and
- The Southwest Afognak Section of the Afognak District.

There will be a <u>57-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Tuesday**, **August 2** to **9:00 p.m. Thursday**, **August 4** in the following areas:

- The Outer Karluk and Sturgeon Sections of the Southwest Kodiak District;
- The **Eastside Kodiak District** (except the Inner Ugak Bay and Outer Ugak Bay Sections will remain closed);
- The Mainland District;
- The Duck Bay, Northwest Afognak, Perenosa Bay, Northeast Afognak, Southeast Afognak, and Raspberry Strait Sections of the Afognak District; and
- The **Humpy-Deadman Section** of the **Alitak District.**

The following areas will **close** to commercial salmon fishing at **9:00 p.m. Thursday, August 4**:

- The Izhut Bay, Inner Kitoi Bay, and Outer Kitoi Bay Sections of the Afognak District.

Closed Water Adjustments:

Closed waters are **reduced** until **9:00 p.m. Thursday, August 4** in **Kitoi Bay** to the ADF&G markers located in Little Kitoi and Big Kitoi bays (near stream #s 252-323 and 252-324).

Cost recovery fisheries are scheduled to begin in the Kitoi Bay Special Harvest Area (SHA) on August 5. Fishing opportunities in the Duck Bay, Izhut Bay, Inner Kitoi Bay, and Outer Kitoi Bay sections will be dependent on the ability to meet KRAA cost recovery needs, and all cost recovery information can be obtained by calling 486-6559.

As previously Announced:

The Spiridon Bay Special Harvest Area remains open until further notice.

Fishermen are reminded that, <u>until further notice</u>, in that portion of the Northwest Kodiak and Southwest Kodiak districts south of the latitude of Cape Kuliuk, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350). Statistical Charts, Harvest Strategies, and Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations are available at the Kodiak Fish and Game office.
