Sand Point Commercial Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #24 For Emergency Order #4-FS-M-SP-20-22

Commercial salmon fishing by **set gillnet and seine gear** will be **extended** from 9:00 p.m. Thursday, August 18 until 8:00 p.m. Saturday, August 20 in the Beaver Bay, Balboa Bay, Southwest Stepovak, Northwest Stepovak, and East Stepovak Sections of the Southeastern District.

Commercial salmon fishing by **set gillnet and seine gear** will be **extended** from 9:00 p.m. Thursday, August 18 until further notice in the following districts and sections:

Unimak District

Southwestern District, **excluding** the inside waters of the Volcano Bay Section north and west of a line from Arch Point at 55° 12.30' N. lat., 161° 54.30' W. long. to a point on Belkofski Peninsula at 55° 09.50' N. Lat, 161° 57.80' W. long. (Statistical Area 284-36) and the inside waters of Belkofski Bay north of a line at 55° 08.00' N. lat.

South Central District

Shumagin Islands Section of the Southeastern District

Commercial salmon fishing by **drift gillnet gear** will be **extended** from 9:00 p.m. Thursday, August 18 until further notice in the following districts and sections:

Unimak District

Ikatan Bay Section of the Southwestern District

All closed waters in the above locations will be as described in the regulation book or as adjusted by emergency order.
