SOUTHERN SOUTHEAST OUTER COAST (SSEOC) SECTOR DIRECTED LINGCOD FISHERY CLOSURE

The directed fishery for lingcod will close in the entire Southern Southeast Outer Coast (SSEOC) Sector at 11:59 p.m., Tuesday, June 13, 2023. The 2023 directed lingcod fishery guideline harvest level (GHL) for the SSEOC Section is 50,100 round pounds. Based on reported landings and communication with the fleet, the department anticipates the GHL will be taken at the time of the closure.

The directed lingcod fishery remains open in the Icy Bay Subdistrict (IBS). Lingcod catches will be closely monitored, and fishermen should expect additional area closures on short notice. Closure notices will be announced by ADF&G advisory announcement, United States Coast Guard marine broadcast, and the National Weather Service marine broadcast.
