KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #16 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-16-22

There will be a <u>105-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Thursday**, **July 13** to **9:00 p.m. Monday**, **July 17** in the following areas:

- The **Northwest Kodiak District** (except the Kizhuyak Bay Section will remain closed);
- The **Northeast Kodiak District** (except the Buskin River Section will remain closed);
- The **Eastside Kodiak District** (except that portion of Pasagshak Bay northeast of a line from a point at 57°26.04' N lat. 152°31.13' W long. to a point at 57°25.44' N lat. 152°29.39' W long, will remain closed); and,
- The **Afognak District** (except the Duck Bay, Izhut Bay, Inner Kitoi Bay and Outer Kitoi Bay sections will remain closed).

There will be a <u>57-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Thursday**, **July13** to **9:00 p.m. Saturday**, **July 15** in the following areas:

- The Outer Avakulik, and Halibut Bay Sections of the Southwest Kodiak District; and
- The **Mainland District.**

Closed Water Adjustments:

Closed waters for Saltery Creek (stream # 259-415) are normal closed waters as described in regulation from **noon Thursday, July 13** to **9:00 p.m. Monday, July 17.**

As previously Announced:

The following areas will close at 9:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 12:

- The **Duck Bay** and **Izhut Bay Sections** of the **Afognak District**.

After 12:01 a.m. July 6, <u>until further notice</u>, within the Kodiak Area only that portion of the Northwest Kodiak and Southwest Kodiak districts south of the latitude of Cape Kuliuk, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Concerning the North Shelikof Strait Fishery:

Short notice, inperiod closures may occur for seine fisheries in the Seaward Zones of the North Shelikof Strait area (including the Cape Igvak Section), as designated in the North Shelikof Strait Sockeye Salmon Management Plan (5 AAC 18.363). Closure announcements may occur at 8:30 a.m., 10:00 a.m., noon, 2:00 p.m., 5:00 p.m., or 8:00 p.m. on VHF channel 6.

Cost recovery fisheries have begun in the Spiridon Bay Special Harvest Area (SHA) and the Spiridon Bay SHA will remain <u>closed</u> to common property fishing. Fishery opportunities in the Spiridon Bay SHA will be dependent on the ability to meet KRAA cost recovery needs. Cost recovery information can be obtained by calling 486-6559.
