PORT MOLLER COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #19 **Emergency Orders #4-FS-M-PM-19-23**

That portion of the Bear River Section located from a 280° bearing perpendicular to the beach at the southern 1,000-yard regulatory marker at King Salmon River to the Sandy River Bluffs located at 160° 19.64' W. long. will remain closed to commercial salmon fishing until further notice. The remaining portion of the Bear River Section and the Three Hills and Ilnik Sections will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 9, until 6:00 p.m. Monday, August 14.
