### **KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #28 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-28-23**

There will be a **105-hour** commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Thursday, August 10 to 9:00 p.m. Monday, August 14** in the following areas:

- The **Halibut Bay, Sturgeon, and Outer Karluk Sections** of the **Southwest Kodiak District**;
- The **Northwest Kodiak District** (except the Uyak Bay and Inner Uganik Bay Sections will remain closed);
- The **Northeast Kodiak District**;
- The **Eastside Kodiak District**; and
- The **Southwest Afognak, Northwest Afognak, Raspberry Strait, and Northeast Afognak Sections** of the **Afognak District**.

There will be a **57-hour** commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Thursday, August 10 to 9:00 p.m. Saturday, August 12** in the following areas:

- The **Southeast Afognak, Duck Bay, Izhut Bay, and Outer Kitoi Bay Sections** of the **Afognak District**;
- The **Outer Ayakulik Section** of the **Southwest Kodiak District**; and
- The **Cape Alitak, Humpy-Deadman, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay Sections** of the **Alitak District**; and
- The **Spiridon Bay Special Harvest Area**.

#### **Closed Water Adjustments:**

Closed waters are **expanded** until further notice, in that portion in the **Southwest Afognak Section** of the **Afognak District**, within one-half nautical mile of the beach near the terminus of Malina Creek (stream #252-105) between 58° 10.00' N lat. and 58° 11.00' N lat.

#### **As previously Announced:**

Cost recovery fisheries began in the Kitoi Bay Special Harvest Area (SHA) on August 5. Fishing opportunities in the Duck Bay, Izhut Bay, Inner Kitoi Bay, and Outer Kitoi Bay sections will be dependent on the ability to meet KRAA cost recovery needs, and all cost recovery information can be obtained by calling 486-6559.

**Until further notice**, within the Kodiak Area only that **portion of the Northwest Kodiak and Southwest Kodiak districts south of the latitude of Cape Kuliuk, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear** in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350). Statistical Charts, Harvest Strategies, and Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations are available at the Kodiak Fish and Game office.
