KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #39 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-39-23

The following areas will be extended from 6:00 p.m. Monday, August 28 <u>until further notice</u>: - The Duck Bay, Izhut Bay, and Outer Kitoi Bay Sections of the Afognak District.

The following areas will close to commercial salmon fishing at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 29:

The Anton Larsen, Sharatin Bay, Kizhuyak Bay, Terror Bay, Spiridon Bay and Zachar Bay Sections of the Northwest Kodiak District.

There will be a <u>54-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Wednesday**, August 30 to 6:00 p.m. Friday, September 1 in the following areas:

- The Inner Karluk Section of the of the Southwest Kodiak District;
- The Northwest Afognak and Raspberry Strait Sections of the Afognak District;
- The Mainland District; and
- The Cape Alitak, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay Sections of the Alitak District.

Closed water adjustment:

Closed waters will be **reduced** from **noon Wednesday**, August 30 to 6:00 p.m. Friday, September 1 in the following area:

- At Karluk Lagoon's exit channel terminus at the ocean shoreline (stream #255-101).

As previously announced:

The following areas are open to commercial salmon fishing **<u>until further notice</u>**:

- The Outer Ayakulik, Outer Karluk, Sturgeon, and Halibut Bay Sections of the Southwest Kodiak District;
- The **Northwest Kodiak District** (except the Uyak Bay and Inner Uganik Bay Sections remain closed; and the remaining inner bay sections will close at 6:00 p.m. Wednesday August 29);
- The Northeast Kodiak District;
- The Eastside Kodiak District;
- The Humpy-Deadman Section of the Alitak District; and
- The Southwest Afognak and Northeast Afognak Sections of the Afognak District.

Closed waters are <u>expanded</u> until further notice, in that portion in the Southwest Afognak Section of the Afognak District, within one-half nautical mile of the beach near the terminus of Malina Creek (stream #252-105) between 58° 10.00' N lat. and 58° 11.00' N lat.

<u>Until further notice</u>, within the Kodiak Area only that **portion of the Northwest Kodiak and Southwest Kodiak districts south of the latitude of Cape Kuliuk**, **Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear** in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350).
