2024 Kodiak District Tanner Crab Season Opening

Emergency Order 4-S-02-24

The National Weather Service marine weather forecast for Area PKZ732 (0–15 nmi offshore; Marmot Island to Sitkinak) issued at 4:00 a.m. January 14 <u>did not</u> contain a gale warning. Therefore, the 2024 Kodiak District Tanner crab fishery will open at 12:00 noon January 15, 2024.

Final registration is required and will occur in Kodiak beginning at 10:00 a.m. January 14, 2024. The Alutiiq Tribe of Old Harbor office is available to facilitate fishery registration by scanning or faxing registrations to ADF&G Kodiak and printing finalized copies for registered vessels.

ADF&G will manage the 2024 Kodiak Tanner crab fishery based on inseason reports from fishery participants. Reports will be taken daily beginning at 6:00 p.m. by phone (907-486-1840), satellite dispatch (7894), email (nathaniel.nichols@alaska.gov), and text/InReach/WhatsApp (907-512-5841). Vessel operators are strongly encouraged to report catch daily.
