Norton Sound Commercial Red King Crab Fishery Guideline Harvest Level Set

The North Pacific Fishery Management Council (NPFMC) met February 12, 2024, and adopted overfishing level (OFL) and acceptable biological catch (ABC) for Norton Sound red king crab.

The total catch OFL was set at 733,000 pounds with an ABC of 513,000 pounds. The OFL and ABC include both retained and discarded catch. The retained portion of the ABC is 483,000 pounds. The Alaska Department of Fish and Game estimates legal male biomass (LMB) to be 4.9 million pounds.

The guideline harvest level (GHL) is set as a percentage of the LMB and must be set so that total removals remain below the ABC.

The department has set the harvest at 9.86% of the LMB yielding a total commercial GHL for red king crab of 483,000 pounds.

By regulation, the GHL for the winter commercial red king crab fishery is 8% of the total commercial GHL and will be 38,640 pounds. Additionally, 36,225 pounds of red king crab commercial GHL (7.5% of the GHL) is allocated to the Community Development Quota fishery.

At present there are 9 permit holders registered for the winter commercial crab fishery. One buyer: Arctic Circle Wild Seafood based out of Kotzebue is registered in Norton Sound for the winter commercial crab fishery. Permit holders can sell crab as a registered catcher-seller or with other State of Alaska marketing programs.

Commercial crab permit holders must register at the Fish & Game office in Nome to receive crab pot tags before crabbing. Village residents can call 1-800-560-2271 to register and crab pot tags will be sent via local airlines.

Those assisting a commercial permit holder must be in possession of a 2024 commercial crewmember license or a 2024 State of Alaska commercial fishing permit for any fishery can substitute. Crewmember licenses are available at the Nome Fish & Game office or can be bought online at www.adfg.alaska.gov/Store/
