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**UPPER COOK INLET COMMERCIAL FISHING ANNOUNCEMENT No. 17**  
**EMERGENCY ORDER NUMBER 2-F-H-20-24**

Commercial salmon fishing with set gillnets will be open in that portion of the Western Subdistrict of the Central District south of the latitude of Redoubt Point from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. on Mondays; from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. on Thursdays; and from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. on Saturdays each week until further notice, effective beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 4, 2024.

Sockeye salmon harvest rates in the set gillnet fishery from the beaches near the Crescent River area are consistent with historic harvest rates when this fishery has been provided additional fishing time due to increased sockeye salmon passage into the Crescent River. Commercial fishing periods will occur three times a week until harvest rates decline, which allows for reasonable fishing opportunity and provides adequate sockeye salmon passage in the Crescent River.
