Port Moller Commercial Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #20 **Emergency Order #4-FS-M-PM-20-24**

That portion of the Bear River Section located from a 280° bearing perpendicular to the beach at the southern 1,000-yard regulatory marker at King Salmon River to the Sandy River Bluffs located at 160° 19.64' W. long. will reopen to commercial salmon fishing at 8:00 p.m. Saturday, August 3, until 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 6. The closed waters at Bear River will be set at 1,000 yards from the stream terminus at the ocean shoreline from 8:00 p.m. Saturday, August 3, until further notice. As previously announced, the remaining portion of the Bear River Section, as well as the Three Hills and Ilnik Sections are open to commercial salmon fishing until 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 6.

Statistical charts and harvest strategies are available at the Sand Point, Cold Bay, and Port Moller Fish and Game offices.
