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Port Moller Commercial Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #21 **Emergency Order #4-FS-M-PM-21-24**

The Bear River, Three Hills, and Ilnik Sections will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 6 until 6:00 p.m. Saturday, August 10. The closed waters at Bear River will remain at 1,000 yards from the stream terminus at the ocean shoreline until further notice. The Port Moller Bight Section will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Monday, August 5, until 6:00 p.m. Saturday, August 10.

Statistical charts and harvest strategies are available at the Sand Point, Cold Bay, and Port Moller Fish and Game offices.
