SUBSISTENCE SALMON FISHING IN SUBDISTRICTS 5 AND 6.

This is an announcement from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) for subsistence fishermen in Subdistricts 5 and 6.

Subsistence Fishing in Subdistricts 5 and 6:

- Effective 12:01 a.m. Sunday, August 11, fresh waters of Subdistricts 5 and 6 will open to gillnet gear with mesh size restricted to 6 inches or less in all fresh waters. Beach seining in the fresh waters of Subdistricts 5 and 6 will close.

As Previously Announced:

- Marine waters of Subdistricts 5 and 6 is open to subsistence gillnet fishing with mesh size restricted to 6 inches or less.
- Beach seining in the marine waters of Subdistricts 5 and 6 remains closed.

The department has switched to management based on coho salmon. All other subsistence fishing schedules and closures in the Port Clarence and Norton Sound Districts are unaffected by this advisory announcement.
