SECTION 11-A (JUNEAU AREA) PERSONAL USE RED AND BLUE KING CRAB SUMMER FISHERY

The 2024 red and blue king crab stock assessment survey results indicate a harvestable surplus to allow the prosecution of the Section 11-A (Juneau Area) personal use red and blue king crab fishery. The fishery will proceed with the following restrictions:

- The fishery will be open from 12:00 noon, Monday, August 19, through 12:00 noon, Sunday, August 25.
- Daily bag and possession limit is 3 red or blue male king crab in combination per household permit.
- Summer seasonal limit is 3 red or blue male king crab in combination per household permit.
- Gear is restricted to 1 pot or 2 ring nets per vessel.
- During the opening, personal use Dungeness and Tanner crab pot gear is also restricted to 1 pot or 2 ring nets per vessel.
- A Section 11-A household permit is required to participate in the fishery and permits are available:
 - Online at www.adfg.alaska.gov/Store/,
 - Douglas Area Office at 802 3rd Street, and
 - Juneau Headquarters Office at 1255 W 8th Street.
- Harvest reports are required for the summer red and blue king crab fishery and can be reported online at www.adfg.alaska.gov/Harvest/ or returned to the Douglas Area office by September 15, 2024.

Residents are reminded that they must be in possession of a valid resident sport-fishing license if 18 years or older prior to harvesting king crab.

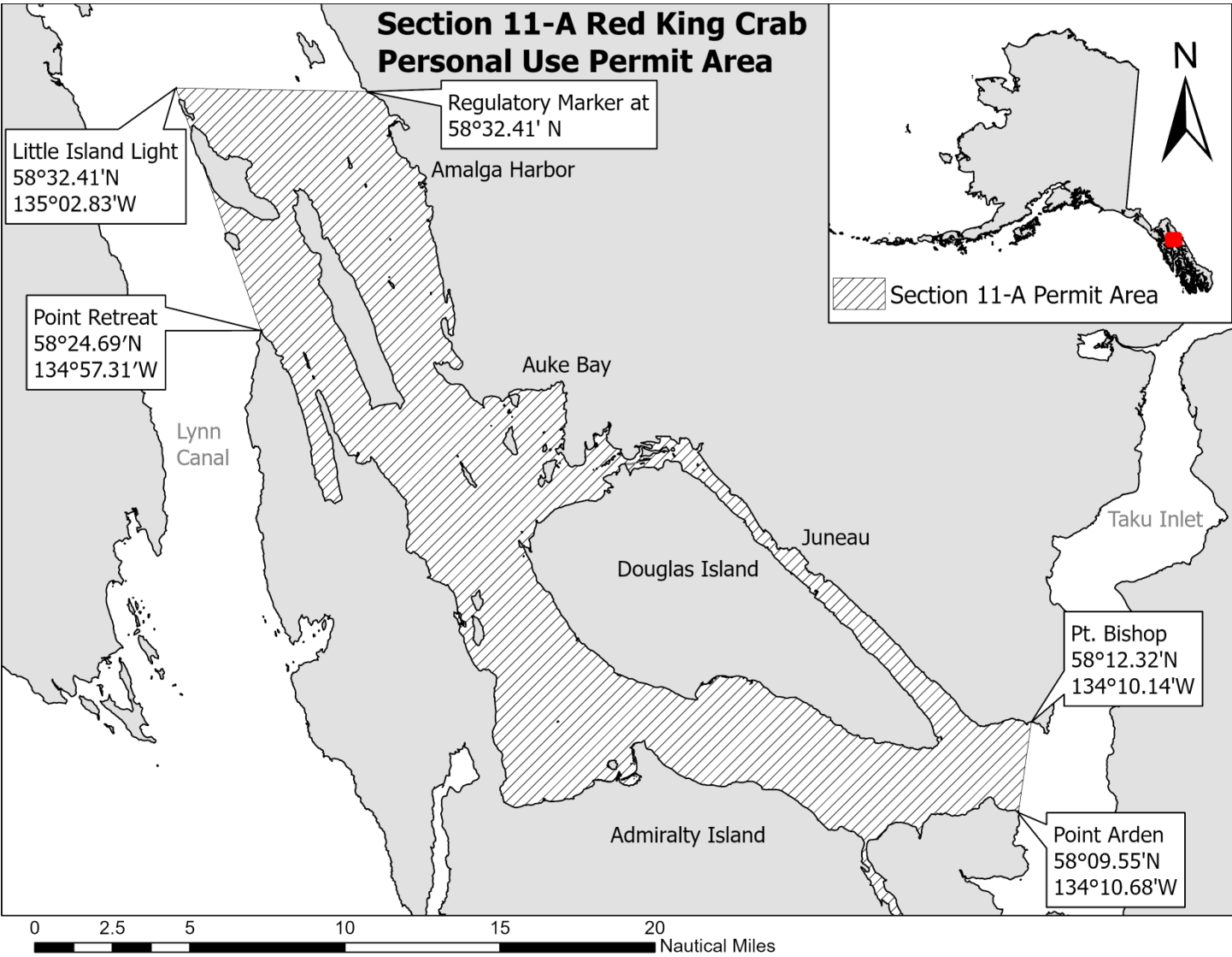


Figure 1. This map shows Section 11-A (Juneau area) personal use fishery and is for reference purposes only. Please refer to text in this advisory announcement for legal descriptions of management area boundaries and other details.

The Juneau Area (Figure 1) includes the waters of Gastineau Channel, Stephens Passage, and Lynn Canal north and west of a line from Bishop Point at 58°12.32' N lat, 134°10.14' W long to Point Arden Light at 58°09.55' N lat, 134°10.68' W long, and south of the latitude of Little Island Light at 58°32.41' N lat, and east of a line from Little Island Light at 58°32.41' N lat, 135°02.83' W long, to Point Retreat Light at 58°24.69' N lat, 134°57.31' W long.
