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Chignik Commercial Salmon Fishery Announcement # 24

For E.O. 4-FS-L-22-24

Commercial salmon fishing will be allowed for 112 hours beginning at **6:00 a.m. Monday, August 26 until 10:00 p.m. Friday, August 30** in the Chignik Bay and Central Districts. The Chignik Lagoon markers will be located at Mensis Point.

Waters within the Chignik Bay District as follows are no longer closed: **in the Chignik Lagoon, waters within a box defined by corners at the points of 56° 18.04' N lat. 158° 35.16' W long., 56° 17'42' N lat. 158° 34.43' W long., 56° 17.34' N lat. 158° 35.22' W long., and 56° 17.41' N lat. 158° 35.37' W long.**

As previously announced:

The current commercial salmon fishing period in the Western and Perryville Districts will be extended for one week from **10:00 p.m. Friday, August 23 through 10:00 p.m. Friday, August 30** except for the Dorner Bay Section of the Western District which will remain closed.

Until further notice, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear in all districts of the Chignik Management Area in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Permit holders are reminded that all closed waters are as listed in regulation 5 AAC 15.350.

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As a reminder, a commercial salmon fishing license holder may not subsistence fish for salmon during the 12 hours before a commercial salmon fishing period or during the 12 hours following the closure of a commercial salmon fishing period.

Statistical charts, harvest strategies, and subsistence fishing permits are available at the Chignik weir and the Kodiak regional ADF&G offices. Fishermen are encouraged to standby on VHF Channel 6 at 9:15 a.m. and 5:15 p.m. daily for fishery updates.
