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SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL SHRIMP POT FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

The following areas will open for the 2024/25 fall/winter season at 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, October 1, 2024. Areas will close when guideline harvest levels (GHLs) are expected to be reached or at the fall/winter season's closure at 4:00 p.m., Friday, February 28, 2025.

District 4: will open. The remaining GHL is less than 20,000 pounds of spot shrimp.

District 5: will open. The remaining GHL is less than 12,000 pounds of spot shrimp.

Fishermen should refer to the "Southeast Alaska Commercial Shrimp Pot Fishery Announcement" from April 17, 2024, for details on reporting, fish ticket, and logbook requirements as well as other information concerning the 2024/2025 shrimp pot season. The weekly reporting requirement for all catcher-processors and catcher-sellers will begin Wednesday, October 9, 2024.

Fishermen planning to participate in the fall/winter season beginning October 1, 2024, will need to reregister for the fishery. Registration is available at Southeast Alaska ADF&G offices.
